Why are my base stations not syncing?

If the base stations have trouble wirelessly syncing with each other, there might be an obstruction in your play area. Check if using the sync cable would solve your issue. For details, see [Do I need to use the sync cable?](#) . Restart the SteamVR app. If you still get an error, reboot your computer and reopen the SteamVR app.

How do I know if my Arlo base station is connected?

Newer Arlo base stations have a single LED, while older base stations have three or five LEDs. If you are not at the same location as your base station, launch the Arlo app or log in to your Arlo account at my.arlo.com: If you can review the video feed from each of your Arlo Wire-Free cameras, your base station is connected to the Internet.

What should I do if my base station is offline?

If your base station is offline, follow these troubleshooting steps in this order: Check the Ethernet cable. Make sure that your Ethernet cable is securely connected to the base station and router and that you're using the Ethernet cable that came with your system. Check the Power adapter.

How do I know if my base station is working?

Step 1: Check the Status Light. Open the electronics box & check to see if the status light (outlined in red below) is flashing green. If it is flashing green, your base station is working. Step 2: Check your Cheat Sheet (if you have one). 'Good' Your base station is working correctly.

Check the ComHub's status LED (to the right of the power button). It should be flashing green. If not, press the power button. If you're using a stand-alone wireless Base Station, connect it to ...

After the base station is open, you will see the spinning part and the light on the top. Locate the plastic holder, to remove it, use a screwdriver to push it out of the socket on the top, then it will ...
