How many power stations does Brunei have?

The BPC operates three power stations: Berakas 1 and 2, Jerudong, and Gadong 3 power stations. These power stations use gas thermal power plants whose total generation capacity is about 280 MW. The DES and BPC power systems are synchronised with a 66kV transmission line. Brunei does not currently import or export electrical power.

How is electricity used in Brunei Darussalam?

Electricity can be generated in two main ways: by harnessing the heat from burning fuels or nuclear reactions in the form of steam (thermal power) or by capturing the energy of natural forces such as the sun, wind or moving water. of total generation

Will Brunei bring new power plants online by 2027 - 2028?

To address this, the government plans to bring new power plants online by 2027-2028 using Combined Cycle Gas Turbine (CCGT) technology, pushing efficiency past 35%. Alongside infrastructure upgrades, Brunei's climate policy mandates a minimum efficiency of 48% for new plants and aims for 30% renewable energy, primarily solar, by 2035.
